- Smoke detectors (Throw away after battery removal)
- Fire extinguishers
- Propane tanks
- Computers

## Fluorescent Bulbs

**Trash:** Call town clerk or A.B.L.E.  
Waste for pricing 672-3569.

**Recycling:** No separate charge.  
Accepted materials include: Glass containers, all tin and aluminum containers, aluminum foil, plastic #1-7. Products must be clean with no caps. *No containers with oil, brake fluid, or petroleum products. No light bulbs. No hardcover books. Recycle plastic bags at participating stores.* Newspapers, magazines, phone books, all paper products not containing metal or plastics. Place in paper bags or cardboard boxes; no plastic bags. Cardboard: All types must be broken down.

**Scrap Metal:** 50 lbs. per customer per week of light iron and flat metal, in links less than 8 feet long and up to 5 inches thick. No charge.

**Miscellaneous items accepted for a fee:** "Big Trash" - Items too large to be taken with regular trash collection—furniture, chairs, sofas, mattresses, big toys, etc. 100 lb. limit. Cost: based on size/weight.

**Appliances without Freon:** Start at \$5 (includes dishwashers, washers, dryers, stoves, gas grills without tanks, etc.)

**Appliances with Freon:** Start at \$15 each (includes refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc.)

**Tires:** Based on size  
**Batteries:** Car \$3 each

**Single Stream Recyclables:** No separate charge. Accepted materials include: Tin and aluminum cans, plastic containers #1-7, glass food and beverage containers, newspaper, office paper, junk mail (no plastic parts), magazines, catalogs, boxboard, and corrugated cardboard. No sorting necessary.

**PaintCare Recycling:** Accepted materials include: interior & exterior architectural paints (latex, acrylic, alkyd) oil-based stains, shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes, preservatives, field and lawn paints. *Leaking and unlabeled containers not accepted.*

**Other Materials Accepted** (some with a fee): Tires, fluorescent bulbs, used motor oil, scrap metal, electronics, leaves, All batteries except vehicle. Visit [call2recycle.org/vermont](http://call2recycle.org/vermont)

## Pomfret

Use the Hartford Recycling Center, commercial service, or Woodstock Fast Trash (see Woodstock).

**Batteries (except vehicle):** Drop off at Town Offices.

## Sharon

Use the Hartford Recycling Center or commercial service.

## Strafford

**Trash:** Durkee's Rubbish provides Fast Trash. Saturday, 9:00 a.m. - 12 p.m. at the South Strafford Fire Station, Route 132.

**Recycling:** Town Recycling Center in South Strafford on Rte 132. No charge. Accepted materials include: Tin & aluminum cans, #1- #7 plastic containers, glass food and beverage containers, newspaper, writing paper, junk mail (no plastic parts), magazines, catalogs, boxboard, corrugated cardboard, scrap metal, and batteries (except vehicle)

## Thetford

The Town of Thetford runs a recycling center and solid waste disposal at their facility.

**Recycling:** No separate charge. Accepted in 6 categories:

**Metal:** Scrap metal (at least 75% metal).

**Glass:** Any colored glass, porcelain, Pyrex, ceramics, mirrors, drinking glasses, window panes (no frames)  
"Anything that Rips:" Brown paper bags, boxboard, computer paper, paper egg cartons, fax paper, hardcover books (covers removed), junk mail (plastics removed), newsprint, glossy, most paper, envelopes, milk cartons corrugated cardboard.

**Plastic & Tin:** #1-#7 plastic bottles, steel, tin, or aluminum food & beverage containers.

**Aluminum Beverage Cans:** All aluminum drink containers which are NOT redeemable in Vermont.

**Redeemable cans,** plastic bottles, glass bottles—All beverage containers with a VT redemption value.

Items still functional, in good shape, and capable of handling outdoor weather (tools, toys, books) can be left for others to pick up and use. NO CLOTHING, FURNITURE, or BROKEN ITEMS will be accepted. The Town of Thetford must pay to dispose of anything that does not find a home.

## Vershire

The Town of Vershire runs a Fast Trash recycling service.

Saturdays: 8 a.m. - 1 p.m.

**Trash:** Residents must dispose of their trash in Town-issued 33-gallon, green trash bags. Bags may be purchased at the Town Office during regular business hours.

**Recycling:** No separate charge.  
**Containers:** Metal cans, glass bottles & jars, plastic bottles, jugs, yogurt, deli containers #1-7 ( please crush), plastic and metal caps & lids, rigid plastic, plastic buckets (clean, dry, remove metal handles), clean aluminum foil (please wash), plastic spouts from cardboard milk/juice cartons, canning jar lids and bands.

**Paper:** Junk mail, newspapers, magazines, boxboard, corrugated cardboard, egg cartons, art paper, mat board, shredded personal papers, brown paper, Christmas wrap (non-foil), butter and frozen food boxes, beer and soda 6-packs, cardboard milk and cream cartons (washed, with plastic spouts removed).

**Batteries:** Drop off at Town Office.

**Non Recyclable:** Plastic bags, foil Christmas wrap, Styrofoam/polystyrene (#6 packaging), dirty tin foil/plates/towels/napkins, incandescent light bulbs.

### Permits

#### Residential Vehicle

Annual Permit Fee: \$20.00 per household (\$14 for second sticker per household) Valid July 1 through June 30. GUV District residents must get permits at their town office or by mail. A one-day permit is available for \$5 at the Administration Office. Permit is required for trash or C&D disposal. No permit required to drop off *recyclables only*

#### Commercial Hauler

Annual Permit Fee: \$50 (+ \$10 application fee) per calendar year. Purchase at Hartford Solid Waste Administration Office,

### Waste Disposal Rates

**Residential Customers:** Recycling is included with your permit fee. One coupon or one card punch is needed to dispose of the equivalent of one large 30-gallon kitchen trash bag (up to 40 pounds) or approximately 50 pounds of Construction & Demolition, tree/brush material, or bulky waste. Two coupons/punches allow disposal of one tire (16-inches or less) without rim. Three coupons/punches allow disposal of one tire (16-inches or less) with rim. Truck and tractor trailer tires cost one coupon/punch per 40 pounds. One car battery may be disposed of for one coupon/punch.

**GUV District Resident Coupons:** \$4.30

each or \$43 per punch card of 10. Available at member town offices and the Hartford Transfer Station administration office.



**Commercial Hauler Chargeable materials:** corrugated cardboard, plastics, mixed paper & newsprint, units with Freon. **All metals are free.**

**Hartford Resident Coupons:** \$3.25 each or \$32.50 per punch card of 10 punches. Coupons and punch cards may be purchased at the administration office Monday-Friday 8-4 and the scale house on Saturday or the treasurer's office in Town Hall (M-F 8:00 a.m. - 5 p.m.).

### Recycling Materials

*\*Please Note: Recyclable materials must be sorted with the exception of plastics #1-7 which can be co-mingled*

#### Mixed Paper:

magazines, catalogs envelopes, white and colored paper, phonebooks. Newspaper: dry and loose Boxboard: cereal boxes, shoe boxes egg cartons, wrapping paper tubes, toilet paper tubes, paper towel tubes, and toy boxes. **NO butter cartons or any boxes that may be put in the refrigerator or freezer. (They are coated with plastic and treated with chemicals.)**

**NO hard-cover books unless cover and binding removed. NO spiral wire from notebooks or calendars, or blueprints.**

**Corrugated Cardboard:** cardboard and brown paper bags. Cardboard must be dry, flattened, and ripped down to 4-by-4 foot pieces and loose. **PLEASE, no animal feed bags with plastic liners.**

**Aluminum Foil:** rinsed foil, pie plates and other foil containers.

#### Aluminum Beverage Cans

**Steel Cans:** Human and animal food cans, cookie tins, jar and can lids

**Scrap Metal:** appliances, coat hangers, and empty *dry* paint cans. Fuel tanks must be completely open and flushed. Barrels must be crushed or punched. All scrap must be primarily metal. **NO liquid, paint, or compressed gas cylinders.**

**Plastics #1- #7: Rinsed and emptied.** No film or bags. No automotive, petroleum, pesticides or cleaner containers.

#### Glass:

All glass containers accepted, along with

broken plate glass and mirrors. **NO frames.**

### Automotive

**Used Motor Oil:** Take to the scale house attendant in see-through containers only (e.g. one-gallon milk jugs or juice containers) **NO mixtures. 1 punch or coupon per gallon if oil is contaminated. Clean Oil= free.**

**Antifreeze:** Take to the scale house attendant in see-through containers only (e.g. one-gallon milk jugs). **NO mixtures. 1 punch or coupon per gallon.**

**Auto Batteries:** Minimum charge of one punch or coupon per car battery, depending on size.

### Clothing, Furniture, & Household Items

Take useable, clean items to The Good Buy Store on Rt. 5 North, (359-4183)

### Leaf/Yard Waste/ Manure

Ask pay station attendant for directions to the drop-off area. This is for leaves, grass, and farm animal manure only. **No dog or cat waste. These wastes contain parasites and pathogens transmittable to humans. No food waste, brush, branches, or other wood.**

### Tree & Brush Material

See scale house attendant. Maximum 4-ft lengths for logs less than 3-ft diameter, and 3-ft length for logs greater than 3-ft diameter. One punch or coupon for 50 pounds.

### Construction and Demolition Material

**C&D Area #1:** Unpainted painted or treated wood, plaster board insulation (hard, soft and blue board), asphalt shingles.

**C&D Area #2 : Wood:** Painted, treated plastered board Insulation: rigid, fiberglass, asphalt shingles.

**C&D Area #3:** Bricks, concrete, poured block.

**Unacceptable in C&D Areas:** Metal, hazardous materials, plastic, trash, tires, liquids, paper, or corrugated boxes.

### Bulky Waste

Includes mattresses, box springs, upholstered furniture, carpeting, padding, and vitreous china (e.g. toilets). Check with attendant. One punch/coupon per 40 lbs.

### Electronics

**VT E-Cycles:** Computers, monitors computer peripherals, printers, TVs and electronic game consoles, VHF/DVD players, power supply cords and charge electronic devices.

### Bulbs

**VT Lamp Recycling Program:** Allowable lamps include CFLs and general purpose mercury-containing lamps; including linear fluorescent lamps less than or equal to 8 feet, U-tube or Circline fluorescent lamps, and high intensity discharge (HID) lamps. **not accepted.**

### Paint

**Recycle with PaintCare:** interior & exterior architectural paints: latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based enamel, stains, shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes, rest preservatives, field and lawn paints. **Leaking and unlabeled containers not accepted.**

### Batteries

**VT Primary Battery Recycling:** Alkaline, and rechargeable batteries may be recycled through Call2Recycle at the transfer station. **Nickel cadmium and lead acid batteries are banned from VT landfills. (See p. 10 for new battery recycling information.)**

### Shipping Peanuts/ Bubble Wrap

Accepted at the office Monday - Friday. Available upon request for reuse.

### Freon

Refrigerators, air conditioners, etc., 5 coupons for Hartford residents and 4 coupons for GUV residents.

## Syringe/Sharps Disposal

To properly dispose of "sharps" and syringes, studies show that a laundry detergent bottle is the way to go; it's the most punctureresistant.

Used syringes and other sharps should be placed inside and collected until the bottle is full. The bottle should then be capped and sealed with heavy duty tap

Label with warning, "Contains sharps and syringes; do NOT recycle." Final steps...dispose of the full bottle in your household trash and let your ga bage hauler know that sharps are present. Do not recycle the container.

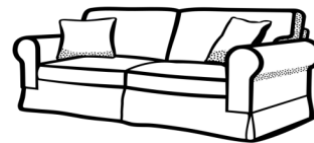
